For the third consecutive year South Carolina Free Will Baptist Churches have broken their record of giving through the SCFWB State Office. Throughout this special financial report edition of the "Informer" you will see who gave this One and a Quarter Million dollars and where the money was distributed. To each of you who gave let me extend a special word of "THANKS" for your contribution and your concern. Only Heaven will reveal what a difference you have made in South Carolina and around the world because of your generous giving.

- Almost \$200,000 increase in giving in 2005 (\$1,077.512.43 given in 2004 compared to \$1,251,780.93 in 2005).
- Giving to the SCFWB Children's Home nearly doubled from \$109,269.80 in 2004 to \$211,976.33 in 2005.
- Generous SCFWB gave \$45,953.46 to help in Disaster Relief in 2005 (See article on back page about Total Disaster Giving).
- 3/4th of this giving (\$900,000) went to ministries outside of South Carolina (Foreign Missions, Home Missions, Colleges, etc).
