A Santa Shop for parents and children to choose items from was also provided for those needing toys and children's clothes. A total of 65 individuals came to serve and deliver food to shut-ins and anyone in need of a meal. Approximately 125 people came to the church to partake of the meal and pick up much needed items from the Santa Shop. Individuals delivering food and gifts were able to reach people staying in ten motels and neighborhoods by just knocking on doors and handing out 425 "to go boxes" – food for the physical body and gospel tracts for their spiritual needs. At one visit, boys were asked if they wanted something to eat. The oldest boy said he had already eaten but he wanted to share his meal with the other two boys that had not had any food yet.
