73rd Annual SCFWB State Meeting



Took place February 26, and 27 at White Savannah Original FWB Church, Conway SC. The Theme for this year's meeting was "Speaking the Truth in Love". Eph 4:15 But speaking the truth in love, may grow up into him in all things, which is the head, even Christ: There was a great spirit throughout the meeting. The Thursday evening offering went to Rev. Todd Smith for almost 8 years faithful service the SCFWB State Office. Rev. Smith has taken a job as regional representative with the FWB Foundation.

There were some items of significant importance to be handled at this year's state convention. One of which was deciding what to do with the former Children's Home located in Turbeville. One year ago the state convention appointed three men; Rev. Tim Hackett, Mr. James Beasley, and Mr. Larry Hawkins giving them the task of searching out a feasible solution to the fate of the former children's home. After much effort, negotiation, and prayer the Committee made the following recommendation at the state meeting.



1. That the Former Children's Home be sold to Falcon Children's Home for continual use as a Children's Home.
2. That the sale price be \$900,000.00 with half to be paid up front and half to be paid over a period of fifteen years.
3. That only approximately 7 acres be sold in this deal and the remaining acreage be deeded to the SCFWB State association with the state office in charge of maintenance and upkeep of the land.
4. That the former director's home be deeded to the state office as a parsonage for the State Executive Secretary
5. That the monies from the sale be placed in an endowment fund with the FWB Foundation, generating 5% ever year to be disbursed among various SCFWB Ministries.

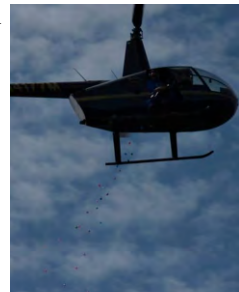
