

In conversations with Rev. Todd Smith (Former SCFWB Executive Secretary presently working for the FWB Foundation) and Rev. Buddy Seay, Jr. (Former SCFWB Assistant Moderator and present pastor of BeaverDam FWB Church of Chadbourn, NC) I discovered that Hillside FWB Church



was their first pastorate and both talked about how the people and ministry of Hillside had helped shape them and the success of their future ministry.

One final illustration- In January of 1964 Hillside had called a new licensed minister (Rev. Lloyd "Pee Wee" Gore) and he needed to be ordained. In order to help the Eastern Conference Presbytery Board with time and travel a 16 year old boy who was up for ordination agreed to have his ordination service at Hillside FWBC with Rev. Gore. And that is a service Mike Jones will never forget.

Hillside FWB Church is not the largest church in South Carolina but its impact has been gigantic. Remember that when you work at, and pray for, your church.

FOUNDED UPON A ROCK

(Biography of William Henry Oliver, 1903-1991)

Saved in a blacksmith shop, Henry Oliver was an ordained Free Will Baptist minister for 67 years. He attended a one-room school, made cross ties with his Dad and played with Cherokee children. A 1926 graduate of Vanderbilt, he turned down an appointment to West Point because that was not God's calling on his life. He was in Eureka (FWB) College's quartet that sang at a Billy Sunday Crusade.

Bro. Oliver was the first pastor of East Nashville, working closely with Bro. J. L. Welch. Yes, that's the Welch for whom Welch College is named. Thirty-five years in public education included being principal at East Nashville High and superintendent of Nashville City Schools.

After "retirement," Oliver taught at Belmont University and Free Will Baptist Bible College (now Welch). Pictures in each chapter enhance the book. You may laugh and cry as you read this book. Included are his last years and his "graduation" day. He was faithful until death and "The Afterglow" he left still inspires many of us whose lives he touched.
