The 76th Annual State Convention hosted by the Beaver Creek was held at Turning Point FWB church February 22-23, 2018. Revival, Renewal, Revitalization was the theme, (Isa 40:31 *But they that wait upon the LORD shall renew their strength; they shall mount up with wings as eagles; they shall run, and not be weary; and they shall walk, and not faint.*)

Registration Committee reported 50 ministers, 17 Visitors, 11 Delegates, 10
National Representatives, and 1 Missionary, for a total of 89 registered. But with nearly 200 in attendance on Thursday night it was one of the best attended state meetings in recent history.

The entire North American Ministries Dept. blessed the convention with preaching and seminars on church revitalization. Rev. Jim McComas spoke Thursday morning on 3 Roadblocks to Revitalization, while Dr. David Crowe spoke on Bearing Fruit John 15:8, Bro. Ken Akers spoke on Leadership, and Dr. Brad Ransom spoke on Creating a Wow Factor for Your Church.

Dr. Joe Arthur preached the house down Thursday night as he encouraged our people to get saddled up, because if a donkey can do it so can you! Luke 19:29-40 Great singing was experienced by Ernie Peters and The Joyaires.

One of the highlights from this year's meeting was the exemplary service given by the people of the host church. The people were there early for every service and met every anticipated need of both the convention staff and attendees. The immaculate facilities, and the servants heart of The Turning Point FWB Church, were a continuous blessing to all who were in attendance. The people of the church were brought on the floor of the convention and given a standing ovation.

#### Convention Business:

- The State Constitution underwent some routine housekeeping and updating. A master copy of the constitution will be kept on the SCFWB website to reflect all current changes.
- A \$1,500.00 scholarship from the Prosser Endowment Fund was awarded to Bradley Bevan who is attending South Eastern.
- The proposed budgets for the State Office, Book Store, and Solid Grounds Coffee Shop, which saw no change from the previous three years, was approved.
- An invitation was voted to be sent to The National Association to investigate South Carolina as a potential venue for the NAFWB Convention and report back at next year's State Meeting on its findings. Next Year's State Convention will be hosted by The Central Association with a venue to be announced. It will held February 28th & March 1st (Because of Leap Year)

**Pastor Paul Reid with the Lord:** Rev. Paul Calvin Reid, 85, of Greenwood, died Thursday, December 28, 2017 at Hospice Care of the Piedmont.

Born in Whitney, SC he was the son of the late Arthur Calvin and Ethel Davis Reid. Paul was a U. S. Navy veteran and attended Spartanburg Methodist College, USC-Florence, Beaver Creek Bible Institute, and Free Will Baptist Bible College. He was the pastor of many churches including Beaver Dam Free Will Baptist Church in Greer, SC, South Avenue Free Will Baptist Church in Lancaster, SC, Westside Free Will Baptist Church in Johnsonville, SC, Shiloh Free Will Baptist Church in Bratt, FL, and First Free Will Baptist Church in Greenwood, SC (which he organized in 1974). Other areas in which Brother Paul served were State Moderator of SCFWB State Association, as a substitute teacher in Johnsonville, a volunteer firefighter in Whitney, and a rescue squad volunteer in Johnsonville.

Surviving in addition to his wife, Mary Amanda Whelchel Reid, is son, Paul David Reid (wife, Leilani Guest Reid, and grandchildren, Maria Amanda Reid and Hannah Grace Reid); and sister, Mary Ardella Gilliland of Spartanburg.

Services were held on Saturday, December 30th at First Free Will Baptist Church (Greenwood) led by Rev. Damon Duncan, Rev. Bob Woodyard, Rev. Donald Davis, and Rev. Chris Todd. Burial, with military honors, followed at Greenwood Memorial Gardens.

Honorary escorts were members of Beaver Creek Association, South Carolina Free Will Baptist Ministers, and members of the Senior Adult Sunday School Class of First Free Will Baptist Church.


