

Because our time will be limited, the focus of this visit will be to visit as many of our supporting churches and friends in South Carolina as possible. Then, in the summer of 2026, we will come to the states again with



the plan of visiting our supporters in the other parts of the U.S. We'd love to start making plans to connect with any of our friends and supporters in South Carolinas during August!

Would you please pray for our efforts to plant a healthy church in the village of Odurne. While we have built relationships with several people in the village and often have good conversations, our weekly gatherings only consist of three people on most weekends.
