Here are some ways that you can be praying for our ministry
in the city of Pleven and the surrounding region:

- Please be praying for our efforts to make contacts in the village of Slatina. Last year we were able to organize a successful kids' week during the month of August and then at Christmas we had a very successful Operation Christmas Child Party. However, we haven't had success in planning anything else since then. Very soon we will be meeting with a family who has shown interest in studying the Bible soon - pray that this will be an open door for more seeds of the gospel to be planted in this village.
- In a little under 2 weeks we will be heading off for a week of kids' camp where we will be looking at the book of Esther. Along with other responsibilities, I (Jonathan) will be responsible for the evangelistic message at the end of the week.
