Greetings from Bulgaria,

Here are some ways that you can be praying for our ministry in the city of Pleven and the surrounding region:

- Please pray for a water shortage that is affecting many parts of Bulgaria, including our city of Pleven. Old pipes, poor planning, and drought are making the shortages worse. Many people in our city and elsewhere are very angry because this keeps happening and there have been several big protests.
- Please pray for the village of Batsova Mahala (Bah-tso-va Ma-ha-la). This is a village in which we have done many outreaches for kids, but have had yet to see any opportunities for discipleship among families and adults. Please pray that God will use the connections we've made with several kids there to open doors for evangelism and discipleship and that in His time we will see a church established in that village.
- Pray for the Bulgarians from both the church in Pleven and in Svishtov who have been stepping up to help keep things going while we have been in the States. Pray that God will use this time without us there to help people in our churches to understand the fact that every Christian has a role in Christ's body.

Friends of India Prayer Letter - August 2025

*The people which sat in dark darkness, saw great light; and to them which sat in the region and shadow of death light is sprung up.' Matthew 4:16

Dear Praying Friends and Supporters,

Greetings to each one of you in the matchless name of Jesus. We are very grateful for your continuing prayers and support for our ongoing work in India ,Nepal and Bangladesh. Our driving aim and desire is that we may take the gospel of Jesus Christ to many in our areas of ministry who have never heard, and that we may disciple those who respond to be faithful followers.

We often don't share numbers of the response to the gospel due to persecution, but many so far in 2025 have been delivered from darkness by the glorious light of the gospel of Jesus Christ. They are now present possessors of eternal life because of your faithful support. There is much opposition to the church and persecution of Christians ongoing in India today.

We have a large work in North India with 300 groups that meet to worship weekly. We have 50 ordained pastors and 95 church planters which help to lead this work. We have 17 churches in South India, and our work is growing there as well. We have established relationships with pastors in the country of Sri Lanka through our work in South India and hope to help with church planting there.

Our boys hostel continues to function on the mission compound where 60 boys have an opportunity to get a good education and they are taught the way of life morning and evening.

We started an English medium school two years ago and now have almost 400 students that come to the mission compound each day where they have exposure along with their parents to the way of life. We dedicated a new church building in India in March and are in the process of completing a building in Nepal.

There are many opportunities for growth where we need more funding. We currently struggle to meet our monthly budget having approximately 2/3 of what we need . Please prayerfully consider increasing what you currently give and we are praying for new churches and individuals to partner with us in this ministry.

God has uniquely blessed this work and much has been given and lives sacrificed to have what we have today. I was reflecting to my wife a couple of days ago that we have much of what we do today because of my parents, faithfulness to stay and work despite opposition, wars, illness, and injuries over a period of many years. We serve the same God today and look to Him to open blinded hearts, and minds and build His church.

With the recent change of address for Friends of India, some have expressed concern that their funds are going to the appropriate place. Let me assure you that all of the funds given to Friends of India go entirely for the work in India. None of the board members of Friends of India receive any financial support nor do I take myself for personal support or for Travel in representing or traveling to India.

We pray for continued blessing on your churches, ministries and your individual lives.


