

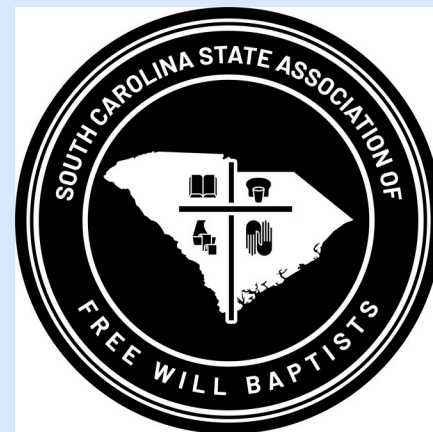

Alejandro and Breanna Johnson (France)

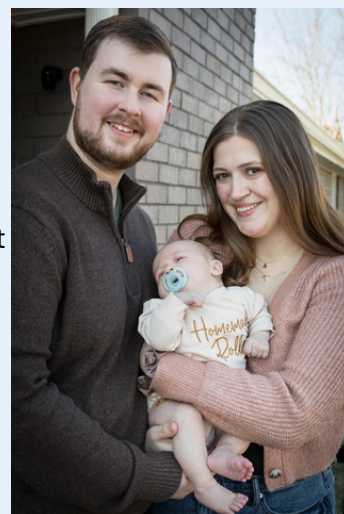
Hello from the Johnsons! We look forward to telling you good news.

We officially have a plan for being in France! An opportunity has come up that will allow Breanna to apply for a student visa! Please pray for her as she goes through the process of being accepted into this school, then having an interview with Campus France (an organization that determines if you are actually intending on being a student throughout your time in France), before she can apply for the student visa itself.

In attending to figure out how to apply for Theodore's passport, we discovered that his social security card was lost or damaged by the postal service. We have an appointment on January 27 to have it reissued. Please pray with us that we will get it soon enough to apply for his visa as well. Our lease here in our apartment in Gallatin ends in March.

Ideally, we would all three have visas by this point and would be heading to France.

However, even if we do not all have visas, we still plan to go to France in March. Our American passports will allow us to stay there for 90 days. During this time, because Alejandro has his visa, we would be able to find a small place to settle in to. Alejandro would be able to teach in person, and Breanna could start attending some French classes. If we do return to the States after 90 days, Alejandro will officially have had his visa for 18 months. This is the specific amount of time needed in order to apply for family regroupment. So, we have several options that may work for us over the coming months. We are so grateful that God opened these doors and lit the way to show us the paths He may have us take. He never stopped working for us, and He works out all things for our good and His glory. Thank you all so much for your prayers and encouragement. We look forward to being with many of you next month at the South Carolina State Meeting!

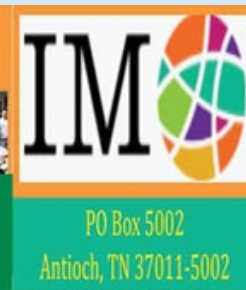

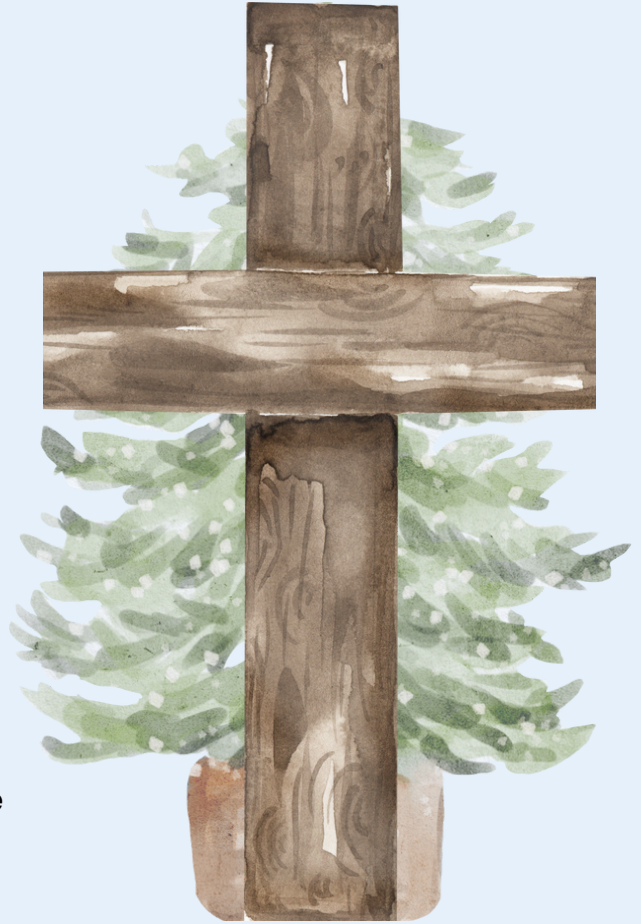
With your support, we will be adding on from the back porch of the church—this is where the new classrooms and expanded auditorium will be built, based on our contractor's recommendations.
